Course Objectives

- To continue to explore with participants the general developmental and religious characteristics of the 6-9 year old child.
- To deepen participants' ability to observe and learn from children.
- To delve into the mystery of God's covenant relationship with us through Salvation History (or Sacred History)
- To meditate on the events of Jesus' life and relate them to our work in the Kingdom of God.
- To reflect on the words of Jesus, particularly those that guide our moral decisions and actions.
- To reflect on Baptism, Eucharist and Reconciliation with particular study of the prayers, gestures and symbols in preparation for receiving Communion and Reconciliation.
- To base this work in the Roman tradition but to include an awareness of the material adaptations to the Anglican, Lutheran & Orthodox traditions.
- To discuss the challenges of engaging 6-9 year old children in the work of Level II
