The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The Level 3 course builds on the foundation laid by the Level 1 & 2 courses. This 120+ hour course will continue to ground the participant in the theory and themes of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd while also concretely preparing her/him to develop and facilitate an atrium community for 9-12 year old children.

The focus of Level 3 is the covenant and how God reveals God's self and is in relationship with us through time: the 'History of the Plan of God'. This theme will be explored through: typological studies of Hebrew Scripture; the History of the Jewish People; a deeper look at sacraments introduced in Level 1 & 2 as well as Confirmation and the Sacrament of the Sick; work on the miracles of Jesus; an expansion of the Level 2 work on the maxims which includes an introduction to biblical virtues and a discussion on organizing "going out" events with the Level 3 children.

The course is presented in the Roman Catholic Tradition but includes awareness of material adaptations to the Anglican, Lutheran and Orthodox traditions.

Prerequisites

Certificates in Level 1 and Level 2.
Sessions 1 and 2 must be completed in sequence



Expectations

- ❖ 100% attendance and engagement in group discussions, prayer and in simulated presentations using the materials.
- ❖ 10 hours minimum observation in a level 3 atrium and/or elementary 9-12 Montessori classroom.
- ❖ Completion of group album through hands-on work with materials, individual writing, group discussion and collaboration.
- ❖ Complete required reading prior to the course.
